

Teaching Kids to Recognize their Name

Lily pads & frogs

DIRECTIONS

Print out on green paper:

Cut out frogs.

Cut out lily pads (You will need a lily pad for each letter in their name).

I bought my frogs and lily pads from the Dollar Tree but created the following frog and lily print outs for those of you who do not have access to that store.



Lily Pad Hop

Write your child's first name on one of the frogs. Have them hold it or tape it to their shirt depending on if they need to rely on the letter order to hop their name. Write each letter of their name on the lily pad, mix them up and lay them on the floor. Have your child hop from the first letter in their name to the second and so on.

Lily Pad Mix-up

Mix up the lily pads that have the letter of their name. Have them put the lily pads in order to form their name.

ChooSy Frog

Write their name on the frogs belly. On the other frog write their name again but jumble the letters. Have them find their name. Mix them up, lie them flat and repeat as long as your child wants to play.
